

Converting images to BW for Myriad

1. Open color image in Photoshop

2. Check Image size and resolution (Image-Image Size): should be 300ppi at the print size needed for page. If it is too small, alert the Myriad team. If it is larger, don't change it.

2. Use Photoshop BW Adjustment layer and Curves or Levels to adjust BW tones to best match tonal relationships in color image.

3. Save as into another folder (adjusted images), add BW to file name, save as PSD

4. Flatten the file.

6. Use Curves adjustment to adjust the blacks to 90%

8. Flatten file, Save as a TIFF, save in new folder MYRIAD FINAL BW
